

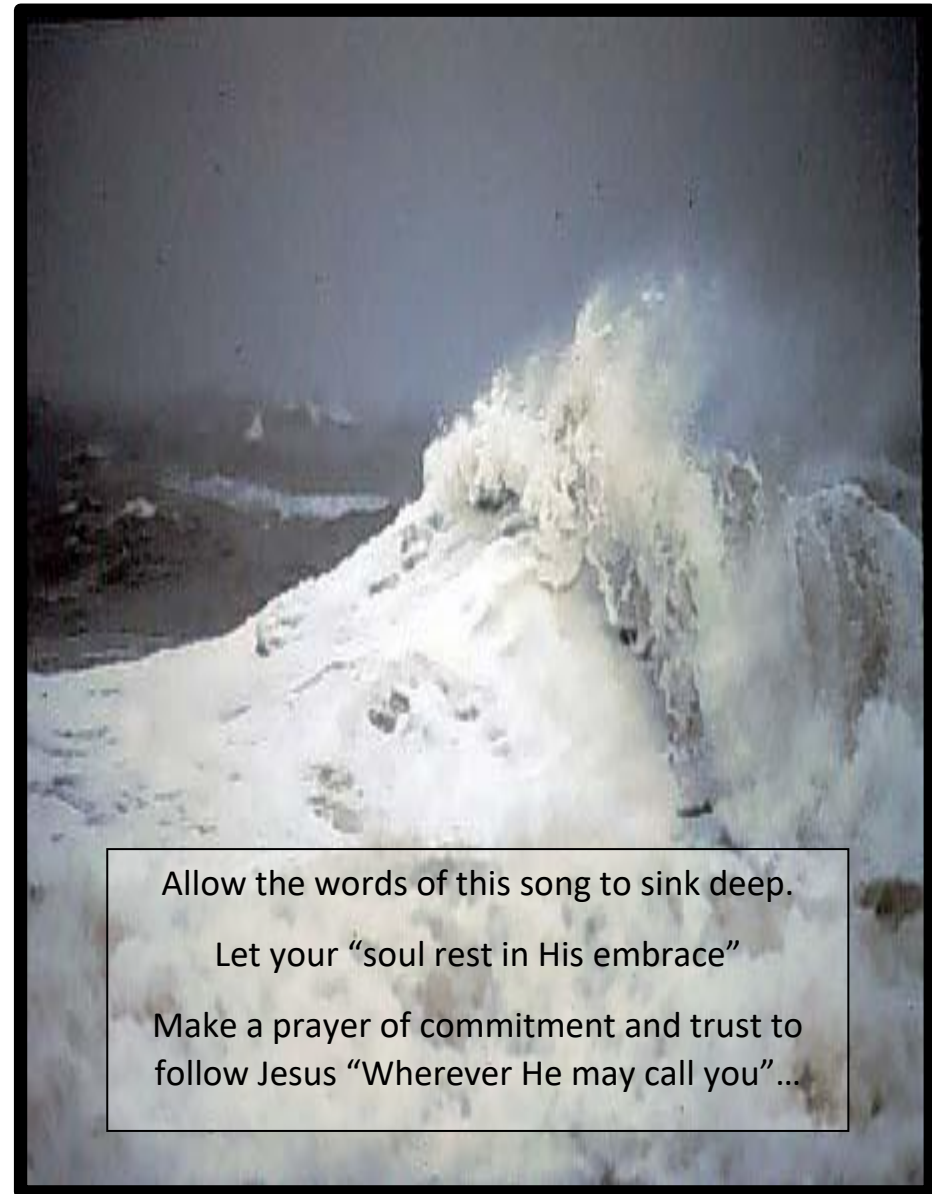
*You call me out upon the waters
