

Worship Leader Training Course

We are starting a Worship Leader Training Course in the autumn and would like to encourage anyone who is interested in Worship Leading in their church (or potential Local Preachers) to come to an introductory evening at St Giles Methodist Church on Thursday 12th September at 7.30 p.m. The evening will include worship, a discussion on the role and requirements of a Worship Leader, an outline of how the course will be taught and some initial work from the course.

The intention for this course is to do some training using material from the new Worship: Leading and Preaching course but it will not require several hours of individual work on-line prior to each session. A minimal amount of preparation may be asked for prior to some of the sessions. Previous students have found the on-line course quite demanding and we hope that teaching the material in a group setting will make it more accessible, relevant and enjoyable.

We will only be doing part of the new course but will be covering the minimum now required by the Local Preachers' Office. An assessed service and one piece of written work will be required. There will be the option of continuing to a higher level and completing the course for those who wish to.

We have set aside 10 Mondays (9.45 to 2.00, fortnightly with a break in December) starting 23rd September. This is provisional, subject to everyone's availability at that time. We expect that the course will be completed by Easter.
